You are invited to submit a bid for the following work:

PROJECT: TOWN OF GROTON -
GENERATOR REPLACEMENTS FOR
ANN AVENUE AND NOANK PUMP STATIONS

Sealed bids will be received by the Director of Finance at the office of the Public Works Department, 134 Groton Long Point Road (across from R.E. Fitch High School) Groton, CT until 2:00 p.m., prevailing time on July 26, 2018 and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Proposals received after that time will not be accepted.

The project involves the replacement of diesel generators and automatic transfer switches at the above locations.

Bona fide contract bidders may secure copies of the proposed Contract Documents after 1:00 pm on June 27, 2018 on the following basis:

- (1) Plans and Specifications may be obtained for a deposit of \$50.00 per set at the office of the Owner located at the above address, or upon receiving the deposit, the Owner will mail Plans & Specifications, charging mailing costs to the Bidder's Express mail account. The deposit amount will be returned provided the Contract Documents are returned in good condition within ten (10) days after the bid opening.

In accordance with the stipulations found in Article 4 of the Supplementary Instructions to Bidders, a Bid Bond (AIA Document A310) may be required as bid security in the amount of 10% of the base bid. A certified check in the amount of 10% of the bid will be accepted in lieu of a Bid Bond. Certified Checks shall be made payable to Owner.

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In accordance with the stipulations found in Article 7 of the Supplementary Instructions to Bidders, a Performance Bond and Payment Bond (AIA Document A312) in an amount equal to 100% of the estimated Contract price recorded in the proposal form of the Contract as executed may be required from the successful bidder for the faithful performance of each of the Contracts. The bonds furnished must be in favor of the Town of Groton and executed by a surety company authorized to transact business in the State of Connecticut and approved by the Director of Public Works and accompanied by a power of attorney.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on July 10, 2018 at 9:00 AM. Bidders should meet at Ann Avenue Pump Station Site, 17 Ann Avenue, Mystic, CT 06355. A visit to the Noank Pump Station, 104 Main Street, Groton, CT 06340 will follow. Bidders are encouraged to visit the sites prior to bidding.

This contract is subject to State set-aside and contract compliance requirements. The contractor must comply with State Prevailing Fair Wage Provisions (C.G.S 31-53(g)).

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularity in bidding.
