Fitch High School) Groton, CT until 2:00 p.m., prevailing time, on November 2, 2017, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope and designated as bid for "Fitch Middle School Phase 2 – Code Renovations".

Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for opening of bids. Any bid received after the time and date specified will be returned unopened.

The project consists of selective renovations for Code Improvements to the vacant former Fitch Middle School including but not limited to: minor site work, minor partition construction with hollow metal doors and frames, remedial firestopping to existing fire walls, accessibility upgrades to corridors and bathrooms, construction of new entry vestibule.

Contract documents, including Plans and Specifications, may be obtained for a deposit of \$100.00 per set (made out to Town of Groton) at the Public Works Department, Town of Groton Town Hall Annex, 134 Groton Long Point Road, Groton, Connecticut 06340, Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, or upon receiving the deposit, the Owner will mail same, charging mailing costs to the Bidder's Express mail account. The deposit amount will be returned provided the Contract Documents are returned in good condition within ten (10) days after the bid opening.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting and walk through is scheduled for October 11, 2017 at 10:00am on site at Fitch Middle School 61 Fort Hill Road Groton, CT 06340.

The Town of Groton reserves the right to waive any formalities or to reject any or all bids.

Each bidder must deposit, with his bid, security in the form of bid bond or certified check subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
