

## New Leaf Restaurant

*The Cloisters*, a branch of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, is a remarkable place to visit. They have beautiful herb and flower garden displays with more than 250 species of plants grown in the Middle Ages.

Our guided tour will not only highlight the gardens, but also the extraordinary medieval architecture, the famed Unicorn Tapestries, brilliant stained glass windows, and illuminated manuscripts.

A short walk through the grounds of the Cloisters is the *New Leaf Restaurant* housed in a restored 1930's cobblestone building surrounded by lush forested surroundings. It has the feel of dining in a Tuscan Inn with its vaulted ceiling. Choose that day from a Special Menu: Homemade Ricotta Ravioli, Chicken Caesar Salad, Mac & Cheese with Chili, Crispy Chicken Wrap, or a Trio of Salads, Sorbet Dessert & Iced Tea, Soda, or Coffee.
