Notice of Adoption of Ordinance #278

Notice is hereby given that the following ordinance was adopted by the Groton Town Council on March 12, 2013:

ORDINANCE CHANGING AND REDEFINING THE VOTING DISTRICTS
IN THE TOWN OF GROTON

The following is a summary description prepared by the Town Attorney per Charter § 5.5.6.2 of the “Ordinance Changing and Redefining the Voting Districts in the Town of Groton” adopted by the Town Council on March 12, 2013. The full text of the Ordinance, including the metes and bounds descriptions of the new Districts and maps showing the existing and the new District lines, is available on the Groton Town website, www.groton-ct.gov and at the Town Clerk’s office, 45 Fort Hill Road, Groton, CT, 06340. The Ordinance: includes legal descriptions of the revised boundaries of the Town’s Voting Districts, which the Ordinance revises to conform to the 2011 Plan of Congressional Districting approved by the State of Connecticut Supreme Court on February 10, 2012 and published by the State of Connecticut Secretary of State on February 15, 2012, and enacts other changes made thereto by the Groton Town Council pursuant to Charter § 3.7; repeals § 6.1 of the Town’s Code of Ordinances, by which the current boundaries of the Town’s Voting Districts were established and described; combines current Districts Four and Five, with the resulting District to be known as District Four; combines a portion of District Eight with District One and rennumbers District Six, Seven and Eight to reflect the combining of Districts Four and Five. Henceforth, District Six will be known as District Five, District Seven will be known as District Six and District Eight will be known as District Seven. This Ordinance shall become effective forty-five days after adoption.
