## **GROTON POLICE K-9 FUNDRAISER**

The Groton Police K9 Unit is pleased to announce that they are in the final phases of purchasing a new police dog and selecting a new handler for the dog. While the selection of the new police K9 has been made, the unit is still in need of funds to support the purchase as well as continued operations, equipment, and training for the Groton Police K9 Unit. To meet this financial need, the unit is extending its previous t-Shirt fundraiser. ## MONTHLY MANAGEMENT REPORTS

### 1. Library (January)

- The Library Director attended a meeting of the grant application review committee where members met with the new director, Jason Mancini, to help set priorities for future grant cycles.
- Presented FY2019 budget to the Town Manager.
- The Job Club had an average of 7 attendees each week with some reporting success in their job search.
- GMTV posted a record 136 digital signage messages.
- Circle of Friends is actively recruiting additional active members.
- The last set of shelving was installed in the Library's local history collection room.

### 2. Water Pollution Control Division (January)

- The Division treated 106 million gallons of waste for the month.
- The Division continues to perform better than the permit requires for total suspended solids (TSS), biochemical oxygen demand (BOD), and other key performance indicators.
- The collection team was busy with manhole repairs, maintenance and other repair work in the system.
- Staff assisted several customers with billing and technical questions guiding a contractor through the CT DEEP process for proper sizing of grease recovery units.
- The Division started hosting two new Ella Grasso Tech junior year students this month who will be job shadowing the laboratory technician.
