

MINUTES  
HARBOR MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE  
THURSDAY, JUNE 19, 2014 – 7:30 P.M  
NOANK FIRE HOUSE

The one hundred seventieth meeting of the Commission was convened at 7:30 p.m. at the Noank Fire House by Chairman Bates, with the following Commission members in attendance: F. Allen, S. Crowley, C. Talbot, B. Gaynor, and Harbor Masters P. Watts and J. Giblin.

Upon a motion by S. Crowley and duly seconded by C. Talbot, it was voted unanimously to accept the March 20, 2014 minutes, as presented.

Harbor Master Watts reported that the Mystic River Dredging Project for this winter is progressing. His biggest concern is the removal of the mooring across from Mystic Shipyard and their relocation.

Harbor Master Giblin reported that he resolved two requests for relocation for deeper water and is working on another for convenience. He also reported that the previously approved dock at 24 Palmer Court will be built by the new owners.

The Bizick Pier extension request, on Riverview Avenue, was presented by Keith Nielsen and discussed by the Commission.

Upon a motion by C. Talbot and duly seconded by S. Crowley, it was voted unanimously that it is consistent with the Harbor Management Plan.

Spicer's Marina "Maintenance Dredging" project was discussed.

Spicer's Marina Stone Revetment along the shoreline project was discussed.

The Town of Groton lining of the sewer pipe from 500 Noank Road to Little Gibraltar pump station was discussed.

Upon a motion by C. Talbot and duly seconded by B. Gaynor, it was voted unanimously to adjourn at 8:36 p.m.
