V. PENDING APPLICATIONS

1. IWA 18-03, Hickey Residence, Septic Repair, 341 Lambtown Road

The Agency asked again where the septic tank would be going. The applicant stated that it would be placed alongside the driveway.

MOTION: To approve the Hickey Septic Repair application for the following reasons:

1. There will be no loss of wetland or watercourse as a result of this project.
2. The sediment and erosion control plan will adequately protect the wetland during construction.

This permit is subject to the four standard conditions.

1. Report of Chair

Scott asked if staff had been able to inspect the area along River Road, south of I-95, for unauthorized filling. Staff stated the area had been inspected and it looked like there

had been no change since the 2009 satellite image aside from two docks, and no signs of recent filling were found.

Ashworth reported that he would not be attending the next IWA regular meeting scheduled for April 25, 2018.
