I. ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Scott at 7:00 p.m.

III. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF May 14, 2014

MOTION: To approve the minutes of May 14, 2014, as written.

Motion made by Block, seconded by Sutphen, so voted unanimously

IV. NEW APPLICATIONS - None

V. PENDING APPLICATIONS

1. Fishtown Road Pump Station Rehabilitation, 230 Fishtown Road

Greg Hanover, Town Engineer, and Tom Loto, consulting engineer, Arcadis U.S., Inc., reviewed the proposal for rehabilitation of the pump station. Hanover delineated the property line between the property owned - the Town Sewer Authority and adjacent land owned by the Board of Education, showing the limited area available for relocation of the components.

The proposed location of the valve vault and bioxide tank was reviewed. The new components will be relocated about 17 feet from the wetland, on Sewer Authority property. The dewatering system for construction was detailed. The burial of the vault and the trench for piping were reviewed. Some trees will be added to the site.

MOTION: To approve the Fishtown Road Pump Station Rehabilitation application for the following reasons:

1. The applicant has revised the plan to move work away from the wetlands and to minimize the potential for spills.
2. There is no loss of wetland or watercourse associated with this project

This permit is subject to the four standard conditions and the following additional conditions:

1. The dewatering plan shall be incorporated into the Erosion Control plan.
2. The Bioxide tank shall be called out as double walled and a detail shall be placed on plan.
3. When in use the dewatering system shall be inspected daily by the contractor and any failures reported to the Environmental Planner.

Motion made by Sutphen, seconded by Furlong. Motion passed unanimously.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

1. Report of Chair – The Chairman asked about the logging operation off Flanders Road. Staff said she was there about a month ago, and the operation appeared to be in order.
