1) ROLL CALL

2) ITEMS OF BUSINESS

A. Tour of West Woods Upper Elementary School, Farmington

At 9:15 a.m., the Committee and staff traveled to Farmington where they met Jim Hoagland of JCJ Architects and toured the West Woods Upper Elementary School. Mr. Hoagland distributed information and floor plans on the school which was completed in 2002 and houses 700 students in grades 5 and 6. The building is approximately 131,000 square feet and cost \$21.6 million.

B. Tour of Smith Middle School, Glastonbury

After a break for lunch, the group traveled to Glastonbury, arriving at 1:30 p.m. for a tour of Smith Middle School. The Committee reviewed information and floor plans provided by Mr. Hoagland. The school was completed in 2000 and houses 1,100 students in grades 7 and 8. The 197,000 square foot school cost \$24.7 million.
