History:

Became a subdivision of the SCCOG in July, 1993, upon the SCCOG assuming all duties and responsibilities of the former Southeastern Connecticut Regional Planning Agency (initially formed in January, 1961).

Powers and Duties:

General: The Commission makes recommendations on planning matters to the SCCOG.

Specific: The Commission performs a variety of advisory reviews.

Appointing Authority:

Planning Commission, with concurrence of Town Council. (CGS 4-124o; Code Sec. 9-219)

Term of Office: As determined by the appointing authority.

Membership:

Number: One member and one alternate from each town.

Requirements: The member must be an elector and a member of the town planning commission; the alternate must be an elector.

Meeting Schedule and Location:

Bi-monthly (January, March, May, July, September, and November) usually on the third Monday at the SCCOG office in Norwich.

Staff: SCCOG staff.

Records: At SCCOG office.
