

NOTICE TO LICENSE DOGS - 2018

**ALL DOGS SIX MONTHS OLD OR OVER MUST BE LICENSED DURING THE MONTH OF JUNE** and wear the tag on its collar at all times. A dog tag must not be used on any other dog other than the dog described on the license bearing the corresponding license number.

State law requires that dogs be vaccinated against **Rabies**. Owners must present a current rabies certificate to the Town Clerk before a dog can be licensed. A new rabies certificate does not have to be presented until the previous one expires, prior to the date of licensing.

Owners of spayed female or neutered male dogs must present a veterinarian's certificate to that effect in order to pay the lesser \$8 licensing fee. It is not necessary to present this certificate every year once the sex of the dog is noted in the licensing records.

Current dog licenses expire on June 30, 2017, and **a new license for the year 2017-2018 must be obtained before June 30, 2018**, or an **additional penalty of \$1.00 per month** will be collected, pursuant to the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut.
