Terms and Conditions of Residential Bulky Waste Transfer Station Permits September 1, 2020 thru August 31, 2021

By accepting your Residential Bulky Waste Permit, you understand the following:

- 1. The permit hangtag must be displayed in the vehicle for which it was purchased, as shown on the receipt issued to you. (Please hang from rear-view mirror. Permit is only valid for vehicle for which it was issued. If you place your hangtag in any other vehicle, the Town reserves the right to revoke your permit, and refund no portion of the fee collected.
2. Use of this permit is for disposal of acceptable materials from your residence only. Use for commercial purposes, or from a commercial location, will result in revocation of the permit, without refund of fees paid.
3. All loads are subject to inspection by Transfer Station personnel. Among the items not accepted here are regular household trash, newspapers & magazines, cardboard, bottles & cans, hazardous waste, stumps, rocks and grass clippings. Call (860) 448-4083 for questions.
4. Loads of material delivered to the Transfer Station with this permit must be segregated by commodity types as indicated on signs, and as directed by Transfer Station personnel. Additional charges apply for items such as appliances and tires.
5. All waste deposited at the Transfer Station becomes property of the Town. No person may remove waste from the facility except from the Give and Take shed, compost, wood chip, pallet or segregated wood areas. Violators may be prosecuted.
6. Additional vehicles registered to the same address may be permitted for no charge by presenting the other vehicle's valid registration at the Public Works Administrative Office at the Town Hall Annex during, or after, the purchase of your first permit. This includes new vehicles purchased by you during the permit year.
7. Dump trucks less than 5cy, trailers exceeding 10' in length, cube vans, step vans, box trucks & stake body vehicles are restricted from entering the Transfer Station on a residential permit. If you have one of these as your residential vehicle, you must buy a \$60 trip ticket per visit at the Transfer Station. (Dump trucks 5cy and larger are deemed commercial and are prohibited for use for residential purposes.)
8. Permits issued for pickup trucks or other eligible vehicles that are later converted to a restricted or prohibited vehicle become null and void at the time of conversion. For example, if you purchase a permit for a pickup truck and later convert the vehicle to a dump body, your permit is no longer valid. Pickup trucks with side rails are not permitted.
9. All safety guidelines and instructions must be followed while at the Transfer Station facility.
10. This permit is valid beginning September 1, 2020 and ending on August 31, 2021. The annual fee is not prorated for portions of that period, nor is it transferable.
